

The Flip (AKA Flipgrid) website and mobile app <u>are</u> going to be discontinued in the fall, only to be made available in the Microsoft Teams app.



Read Along in Google Classroom



In June, Google officially rolled out the **Read Along feature in Google Classroom.** This feature helps
students build their independent reading skills enabling
teachers to assign differentiated reading activities, based
on Lexile measures, grade level, or phonics skills.
Students read stories out loud and their digital reading
buddy, Diya, gives the students real-time feedback and
assistance and pronunciation support.

You must have the Education Plus or Teaching & Learning Upgrade to use this feature.
