## THE DO'S AND DON'TS

<p><b>Address AI use in your class, set expectations</b></p> <p><b>Ask AI for help lesson planning, preparing activities, and personalization/differentiation</b></p> <p><b>Adjust lessons or create new learning experiences that A.I. cannot do for students</b></p> <p><b>Use A.I. to provide timely and constructive feedback to students</b></p>	<p><b>Don't treat A.I. like a substitute, it is a supplement</b></p> <p><b>Don't enter any students' personal information in A.I. chatbots</b></p> <p><b>Don't ignore A.I. - it is going to be everywhere. Be proactive, not reactive</b></p> <p><b>Don't blindly trust everything A.I. generates. Check for accuracy, bias, and relevance</b></p>

# RULES FOR AI IN THIS CLASSROOM

**Use AI responsibly and transparently to enhance learning, not replace it.**

## RESPONSIBILITY

Take **responsibility** for your learning and develop your own skills.

## TRANSPARENCY

Anything generated by AI must be **clearly marked** and distinguished from your own work.

You must **be prepared to discuss** your thought process or explain how you used AI to inform your work.

## INTEGRITY

Only use AI tools **if explicitly instructed** to by the teacher

Using AI to plagiarize or submit work that is not your own is a **serious academic integrity violation.**

You are responsible for ensuring that all information you submit, regardless of the source, **is accurate and properly cited.**
