CUYAHOGA FALLS, OH – (Nov. 28, 2017) - Northeast Ohio Network for Educational Technology (NEOnet) has been involved in Ohio's eFinancePLUS software conversion to PowerSchool eFinancePLUS since its inception. The software is offered as one of NEOnet's service options for districts and helps streamline their financial, payroll, accounting and human resource systems.

Over 50 school districts across the state of Ohio have implemented the PowerSchool eFinancePLUS software. NEOnet is proud to use the software as well.

"NEOnet has been working with the Ohio Association of School Business Officials (OASBO) and the Management Council: Ohio Education Computer Network (MCOECN) to ensure that school districts' transition to PowerSchool is a success," said Executive Director Matthew Gdovin.
